- Partnering with social housing providers preferred credit unions/CDFIs: Repc Ltd do not offer credit facilities directly but can work with socially responsible lenders through partnerships with social housing providers.
- Providing digital skills training: Repc Ltd do provide basic digital skills training to social housing customers in West Midlands areas near to their office base (West Bromwich).

Alternatively, Repc Ltd are happy to discuss bespoke partnerships and offers with individual organisations.

Added Value

Repc Ltd have many years experience working with social housing providers and public organisations. The company is committed to being a socially responsible organisation. They have a registered UK online centre in the West Midlands, where they deliver digital skills training and work in partnership with charities. They also provide training and employment opportunities for disadvantaged people and run a pre-apprenticeship mobile technologies scheme for young people aged under 16.

CHI Review/Opinion

RePc offer a cost effective way to provide basic, affordable computers which can fit well with wider digital engagement and skills initiatives. The free refurbishing service could help to reduce social housing providers' ICT costs which could enable other digital inclusion activities to be funded.

Their social purpose came through strongly in their presentation, and they demonstrated willingness to get involved with digital skills programmes. Currently, however, the 'added value' elements of their offer are only available on a local basis in the West midlands.
